Dear Mr Samak:

During Tuesday's hearing you asked if I would support a Stand-alone rail-shuttle if it were integrated with the transit system. On reconsideration I found the question highly speculative and hypothetical. One, because an integrated stand-alone shuttle is a contradiction in terms; two, because I don't think it is technically feasible as proposed.

I felt as I was being asked if it was technically viable. It could be but because of the very definition of stand-alone only minimal integration is possible. I don't think it is economically viable. Therefore for this and other reasons I cannot support a Stand-alone shuttle.
