To the Uranium Mining Commission:

There is growing concern about the toxic effects of uranium in drinking water. Evidence from laboratory animals and humans justify a complete re-evaluation of uranium exposure levels which are likely to increase if mining is initiated. Current data does not provide a clear no-effect concentration particularly for vulnerable groups such as children and adults with chronic diseases. Under the precautionary principle the Quebec Government needs to insure that it first does no harm.
