I would like to ask for a correction, modification to a statement I believe to be very misleading.

MR. DENIS ROULEAU stated:

No, we did not give any sort of bribe to anyone.

My reason for seeking a correction is as follows...

Many times over the course of these hearings, it was stated that Mr. Rouleau has offered \$2 per ton of garbage to Danford Lake and is also in negotiation with MRC Pontiac for an additional \$2 per ton.

His statement of not giving a bribe to anyone was his answer to a question asking if he had "offered" any incentive, not if he already "gave" any incentives to anyone. But irregardless of this, whether or not he already "Gave" a bribe/incentive I would like the record to show that he has indeed "Offered" incentives or "Bribes" since the definition of **bribe** in the Merriam, Webster dictionary is as follows...

ONE: money or favor given or **promised** in order to influence the judgment or conduct of a person in a position of trust.

AND TWO: something that serves to induce or influence.

By offering \$2 per ton to the municipality and negotiating an additional \$2 with the MRC Pontiac, he is most certainly offering Incentives or bribes to people in a position that would help him bring his project to fruition.
