Re: Implementation and operation of the Vents du Kempt wind farm in the territory covered by the municipalities of Ste-Marguerite, Causapsal and Ste-Florence

Dear Chief Metallic;

As mentioned in our telephone conversation of last week, Vents du Kempt Inc. ("VdK") has been working on the development of the Vents du Kempt wind farm project since 2002 and on June 27th 2008, executed a Power Purchase Agreement with Hydro-Quebec Distribution for the supply of the project's electricity as of December 2014 for a 20 year period.

Initially developed to be submitted in Hydro-Quebec's first RFP for wind power (AO 2003-02), the project was unfortunately not included in the eligible area for the call for proposals. It was then submitted in the subsequent Hydro-Quebec RFP for 2000 MW of wind power (A/O 2005-03) in September 2007. In May 2008, Hydro-Quebec selected the project among 15 retained for the supply of wind generated electricity.

Wind monitoring equipment has been installed since 2003 and recording wind data on a continuous basis, providing an excellent knowledge of the wind resources in the project area. Various environmental work was initiated in 2005, including avian migration in 2005 and 2006 and bat surveys in 2007. We have more recently been pursuing the environmental data collection with the intent of completing the full environmental inventory of the project area and identifying the project impacts and concerns.

The project shall consist of the implementation of 50 wind turbines with an individual installed capacity of 2.0 MW, for a total installed capacity of 100 MW. The project area consists of more than 85% of privately-owned land, mainly consisting of forestland, and the remaining percentage consists of public lands under the delegated authority of the Municipal Regional County of Matapedia.

We are appreciative of your acceptance to our request for a meeting next week to provide you with more detailed information about the project, to ascertain the understanding of the project and to obtain concerns and issues as raised by the Listuguj M'ikmaq First Nation.

We are looking forward to our meeting next week. In the event you have any additional questions, please do not hesitate to contact me in the meantime.
